Items Needed / Boutique Ideas:

To make fire-starters:

Paper egg cartons (not styrofoam)
Dryer Lint
Used fabric softener sheets
Candle stubs

For purses, bags, card holders, phone bags, etc.:
Men's neckties.
Old jewelry / brooches.

For "Garden Art"

Bird feeders, waterers, garden "totems:"
Colored, unusual shaped wine / liquor bottles.
Colored heavy glassware (vases, plates, containers, etc.)
Heavy, plain glassware.
Pottery (vases, bowls, etc)

More Garden art:

Old bowling balls and bowling pins.
Pieces of colored glass.
Flat-backed marbles.
Styrofoam packing boxes (like Omaha Steak boxes).

For bird houses :

Large, colored laundry detergent jugs.

Old license plates.

Miscellaneous:

Corks (Cork boards, wreaths, etc.)
